

NOTIFICATION TO ABUTTERS NIGHT TIME DETOURS

MWRA Contract No. 7621- Stoneham-Reading Emergency Connection

Please be informed that construction activities, including controlled blasting, will require nighttime (9PM – 5AM) vehicular traffic to be detoured. Detours are necessary for safety while MWRA contractors install a new 36-inch water main along the southbound side of Rt. 28 from South Street in Reading to North Street in Stoneham. **Direct abutters and emergency vehicles will always be allowed access during construction.**

Primary Detour # 1 – (shown in red on the map on the reverse side of this notice) will be set up at night for the portion of the work that includes construction under Rt. 128 and on either side of the Rt. 128 on/off ramps along southbound side of Main Street, near the Stonehill Towers residential complex.

Temporary message boards, detour signage and police details will be in place for all required detours to safely direct nighttime travelers off Rt. 28 in Reading down South Street, over the Hopkins Street overpass and onto Prospect Street in Wakefield; Prospect Street in Wakefield becomes North Street in Stoneham.

Secondary Detour #2 - (shown in yellow on the map on the reverse side) will be in effect when the contractor is working in the intersection of North Street and up to the Stonehill Towers Complex in Stoneham.

This detour will require any vehicle going north in Stoneham (except for direct residential abutters and business property owners) to travel onto Broadway, then left onto High Street and then, in Wakefield, across Prospect Street, onto Hopkins Street, then left on South Street to RT. 28 in Reading. Secondary Detour #2 will require anyone wishing to go south from Reading to travel on South Street, to Hopkins Street across Prospect Street onto High Street and right on Broadway in Stoneham.
