Thank you for taking the time to review the annual drinking water report provided to you in partnership by the Lynnfield Water District and the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA). We are all pleased to be working with the MWRA in providing information regarding the quality of your drinking water. This annual report provides detailed information on the MWRA's source reservoirs and the quality of water as determined through federal and state testing guidelines.

The MWRA is constructing a new pipeline connection for the LWD from Saugus to the Route 1 pumping station. When completed in early 2013, this will enhance the District's ability to adequately accommodate its consumers and allow for additional consumption demand by future developments. The system-wide meter replacement program is now completed.

The LWD continues its Lead and Copper testing program. We test ten homes, twice a year. The 90th percentile level this year was 1.9 ppb, which is below the Lead Action Level of 15 ppb. Please read page 5 for more information on lead in tap water. We again thank the residents who participate in collecting water samples for this program. We will continue delivering quality water to all consumers.
